Dear Ms. Rojas:

We have approved your amendment to Authorization No. WH5011 (issued pursuant to Section 6204(c) of Act 90 of 2002 (P.L. 596, No. 90) to **add** waste transportation vehicles to transport municipal or residual waste to a processing or disposal facility in Pennsylvania. I have enclosed **4** authorization stickers for your amended authorization.

Transporting municipal and residual waste in Pennsylvania carries responsibilities. You must comply with the following:

- (1) The conditions specified in your authorization.
- (2) All applicable provisions of law (Act 90 of 2002, Act 97 of 1980, Act 93 of 1988 and Act 101 of 1988).
- (3) The Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) Municipal and Residual Waste Management Rules and Regulations (Pa. Code, Title 25).
- (4) Any other Federal or State statute relating to motor vehicle safety or environmental protection of the public health, safety and welfare.
- (5) Any rule of the Department.
- (6) Any order of the Department.

Authorization stickers must be placed on all vehicles specified by this authorization – left front side of truck or truck tractor and on trailer, lower left front side and lower left rear/back (two stickers for trailer). Place final authorization stickers over interim authorization stickers so that a minimum of ¼” and a maximum of ½” shows on two sides. Authorization stickers are not assigned to any specific vehicle. Please follow the application instructions on the back of the sticker.

This authorization is transferable under conditions set forth in Act 90 of 2002, Section 6204 (i)-(j). You are required to notify the Department when authorized vehicles are no longer owned by you. Notification must include the Vehicle Identification Number, type of vehicle, date of removal from the WTSP and the DEP Authorization Sticker Number. If the vehicle is not transferred, you must make a diligent effort to remove or otherwise obliterate the DEP Authorization Sticker.


Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, P.O. Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board’s rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board’s rules of practice and procedure are also available in braille or on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at 717-787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.

IMPORTANT LEGAL RIGHTS ARE AT STAKE, HOWEVER, SO YOU SHOULD SHOW THIS DOCUMENT TO A LAWYER AT ONCE. IF YOU CANNOT AFFORD A LAWYER, YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE PRO BONO REPRESENTATION. CALL THE SECRETARY TO THE BOARD (717-787-3483) FOR MORE INFORMATION.
